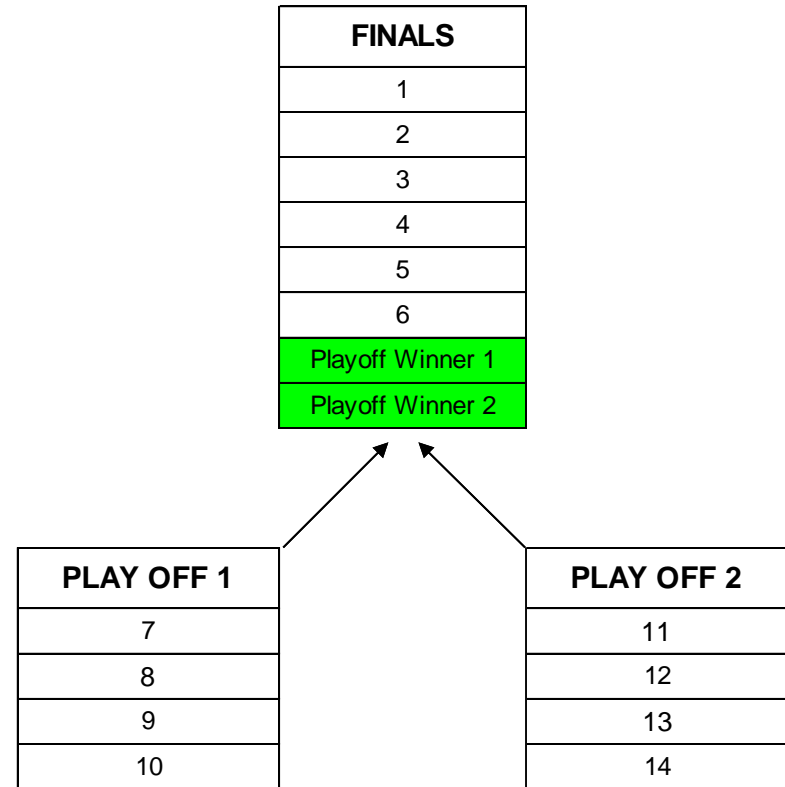

(effective from 1st January 2023)

REVISED STRUCTURE FOR 14U, 12U, 11U COUNTY CUP EVENTS

- Top 6 counties (boys & girls separately) given direct entry to the Division 1 County Cup Finals. These counties do NOT have to play qualifying
- Next 8 top LTA ranked counties placed in 2 groups (4 counties per group) and they play-off to determine which county progress to the Division 1 Finals (1 county from each group per gender)
- 8 counties to then compete in the Division 1 Finals (6 automatically and 2 from play-offs)
- Area Leagues of 4-6 counties and based, as far as possible, geographically close to one another. This is a one-off Event and counties playing in these groups do NOT progress to the Finals but become group winners
- LTA rankings (to be consist with other graded competitions) as of 5 months ahead of the relevant Premier Finals will be used to determine placing of counties within relevant group. Counties will be placed into the group based on the combined rankings of their top 4 players
- Groups will be revised each year and formulated of different counties according to the LTA Rankings for that particular age group

PREMIER FINALS, PLAY OFFS & AREA LEAGUES

- Top 6 counties based on LTA Rankings directly through to the Finals →
- Next 8 counties based on LTA rankings will be split into two groups, based on player rankings and location where possible →
- Area Leagues to be made up of groups of 4-6 counties based on geographic location as much as possible →
