MESSAGE OF WELCOME

from Sandi Procter, LTA President

'County Week' is upon us again and I would like to wish a warm welcome to all players, volunteers and spectators who make this such a special and historic event in the tennis calendar. County Cup tennis, and in particular, 'County Week,' is now 127 years old making it the oldest domestic tournament. It has come a long way since it started in 1895 when the men's event was won by Gloucestershire and in 1899 when the women's event started and was won by Surrey

I am very much looking forward to my first 'County Week' as LTA President. County Cup has always been a favourite event for me and I believe a favourite for many of you too. It is the backbone of British tennis with all age groups from 8U (introduced in 2022) through to Over 80s (introduced in 2023).

The LTA hugely values the role of the counties in helping deliver and support tennis across the country as well as providing competitive opportunities for players of all ages. We invest around £3m a year in the county structure and know how so many people give up their time and resources to keep county tennis healthy.

This week, over 800 players will represent their county. At the top level we welcome Nottinghamshire Ladies reaching, Group One for the first time, and a welcome back to Leicestershire Ladies and Surrey and Suffolk Men who are returning to Group One after just one year in Group Two.

Despite the challenges the event is faced with in the modern world; financial, family and time pressures, greater emphasis on sustainability, the high temperatures of 2022 and the ever-changing climate – the event continues to be at the forefront of British tennis for well over a century. In recent years, we have seen top elite players such as Katie Boulter, Harriet Dart, Jodie Burrage, Jack Draper, Joe Salisbury and Dan Evans to name but a few as regular players on the circuit before their careers took off.

Of course, none of this would be possible without the support of the venues, officials and volunteers who put in an enormous amount of effort both on and off the court. I am always impressed by the wonderful welcome that venues give to teams including the preparation of first-class courts and provision of excellent catering, thanks to the generosity of club members. Thanks also to the team captains for organising players and creating that team spirit that is so unique to County Cup. Also, to the County Associations and Councillors for supporting with administration and being courtside cheering.

I look forward to seeing a flurry of posts on social media with the results of each day's close encounters, and sharing the excitement and tension of what always seems to be a crucial final day. For everyone, whatever part you play, I hope the week is full of fun, camaraderie, good weather, social interaction and fast-paced, hard-hitting grass court tennis. Enjoy!

LTA SUMMER COUNTY CUP EXPLAINED

The LTA County Cup Events give players the opportunity to represent their county in a competitive team environment and the age group categories range from 9U through to the open age groups!

The LTA Summer County Cup Event is possibly the oldest tennis event on the domestic calendar with Gloucestershire men being the winners back in 1895 and Surrey winning the first ladies event in 1899.

The 44 competing counties are organised in six groups of six counties per group and two groups of eight counties on a league basis in both the men's and ladies' events.

Group 1 is the premier group with the men's and ladies' teams playing at Devonshire Park, Eastbourne with the top counties in this group winning the County Championships. The other men's and ladies' groups play at 12 grass court venues throughout the country with the leading two counties being promoted to the group above them. The bottom two teams are relegated to the group below except, of course, those in Group 7.

Each county team consists of three doubles pairs. Over the course of the week, each county will play every other county in its group. Each match consists of every pair in one team meeting every pair in the other over the best of two tie-break sets and a match tie-break (to 10 points), thus making nine rubbers in each match. The team scoring the most rubbers wins by a score which can vary from 5-4 to 9-0.

At the end of the week, the county winning the most matches is the winner. Should, as is often the case, two or more counties be level on matches, the winner of the group, or County Champion, is decided in favour of:

- a) The team with the greatest number of match points
- b) If match points are equal, the team with the greatest number of rubber points
- c) If only two teams are level on match points and rubber points; their head to head result
- d) If more than two teams are level, the percentage of sets won out of sets played (if after this calculation, only two teams remain level, their head to head result will be used to break the tie)
- e) If more than two teams are level, the percentage of games won out of games played (if after this calculation, only two teams remain level, their head to head result will be used to break the tie)



Therefore, every county not only wants to win every possible match, but every possible rubber, set and game.

Over the course of the week a team (county) will play a maximum of 45 rubbers (ie) 9 rubbers per day and, as demonstrated later in the programme, assuming a player is nominated to play in each rubber on every day it is possible for them to win 15 rubbers out of 15 rubbers which is a unique feat and one that is recognised.

Players umpire their own matches and there are no ballboys or ballgirls.

All rubbers shall be the best of two tie-break sets and a match tie-break (to 10 points).

Counties may nominate a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 players.

Team nominations listed in this booklet are provisional nominations and may not reflect the Final Team Nominations which are submitted to the Referee 30 minutes before the commencement of play on the first day.

Daily nominations must be submitted 15 minutes before the start of each day's play, and cannot be changed. In the event of a pair having to concede a rubber, because of injury, or for some other reason, the score is recorded as a 6-0, 6-0 win by the other side.

LTA 'COUNTY CUP RACE' EXPLAINED

WHAT IS THE 'COUNTY CUP RACE'

The County Cup Race recognises a County's performance in all County Cup Events. Points will be allocated after each event, starting with the 18U Event in March and will conclude with the Winter County Cup Event in November.

The County with the most points across all Events will be recognised as the overall County Cup Race Champion for that year. In addition, recognition will also be made to the county making the biggest year on year improvement on their previous year's final position.

- Points are awarded per County Cup Event (male and female events)
- For the Summer, Winter, Over 35s and 18U County Cup Events counties will receive 'initial' base points according to the group they are in and then additional ('group') points according to their final group position
- The points for the 14U, 12U, 11U, 10U & 9U County Cup Events are cumulative based on their success at the group stage and the finals stage (if applicable)

JOHN JAMES OBE

20 June 1937 - 13 June 2023



Originally from Llanelli, John was voted council member for the Welsh LTA in 1963 and was very much involved in junior tennis for much of the following decade and became an international umpire – officiating at The Championships, Wimbledon.

He was elected to represent Wales within the LTA Council in 1972 eventually becoming Assistant Secretary in 1973 and, amongst many roles, was responsible for the organisation of Davis Cup and Wightman Cup ties. He eventually became full LTA Secretary in 1983 through to 2002 and served on the LTA Board of Management from 1983 – 2002.

During his career, John was very much involved both nationally and internationally - becoming President of Tennis Europe from 2003 – 2008, was a member of the ITF Olympic Committee from 1991 through to 2009, becoming an Honorary Life President in 2017, and was President of Middlesex Tennis from 2003 and acting Chairman of the (Middlesex) Board in 2021 - 2022.

In recognition of his services to tennis, he was awarded the OBE in the 2003 New Year's Honours List.

John was a staunch supporter of County Cup tennis, particularly 'County Week', and made a point of enquiring where the respective Middlesex teams would be playing so that he could ensure he was able to go and watch, support and catch-up with his many friends.

He was a warm, friendly man full of sound advice and will be very much missed. Our thoughts go to his widow, Pat, and the rest of the family.

The LTA County Cup team were very saddened to hear of the recent death of John James on the 13 June.

THE 15/15 CLUB EXPLAINED

The LTA Summer County Cup is a traditional, annual inter-county team event consisting exclusively of doubles. It is played on grass, usually during the third week of July.

As most followers of 'County Week' know, this is top quality, hard fought tennis with the pride of playing for one's county at stake; for many this is the pinnacle of their tennis careers.

Over the course of the week a county team plays a maximum of 45 rubbers, (ie) 9 rubbers

per day. As shown on the Roll of Honour below, assuming a player competes in every rubber, it is possible for him/her to win 15 out of 15 rubbers - an exceptional achievement! A more detailed Roll of Honour can be found on the Adult County Cup area of the County Cup website.

County Week data went on-line in 2010 and, unfortunately, records of anyone accomplishing the 15 out of 15 milestone prior to this date is limited and so if you know of anyone who has done so, we would like to update our records so please e-mail countycup@lta.org.uk.
